

Ph.D. Selection Process, Shortlisting Criteria, Academic session: June 2022
HSS, IIT Jammu

The faculty board and DPGC members from HSS department decided the following shortlisting criteria for the selection of Ph.D. candidates in HSS :

Interested scholars should have a Masters degree (with at least 60% marks or equivalent CGPA,, for general and 55%, for SC/ST and OBC, candidate) in the related subject/field will be considered for English/Culture Studies, Philosophy, Sociology/Social Sciences, Communications, Psychology and Cognitive Science) within the broad areas of Humanities and Social Sciences and they should also be UGC/NET qualified. Candidates from the Science/Tech/Engg background should have an MA equivalent Degree (M.Tech/M.Sc/M.CompSc. etc) and a valid GATE/NET score.

However, 5 % relaxation will be provided to the exceptional candidates as per the discretion of the selection committee on the basis of their application submitted (paper publications, statement of purpose, research proposal, experience, etc).

Discipline-wise CGPA cutoff

Economics: ≥ 7 (for Gen candidates and not less than 6.5 for SC/ST/PWD/EWS candidates.)
